Pitch and Putt Ireland Hon. Secretary's Report 2020

Mr. President, Fellow Officers, Patrons of Pitch and Putt Ireland, representatives of Regional/County Boards and Clubs, I present my report for 2019 to Convention.

Firstly, I want to express my sympathies to all in Pitch and Putt and their families who have lost near and dear ones over the year.

On the domestic front, we changed our name to Pitch and Putt Ireland. In the beginning we had a little bit of bother when a former member in the Youghal area informed us that he owned the name, however we checked this out and we had the name "Pitch and Putt Ireland" registered in 1989. The person involved was informed of this. As we all know we continued to have problems with our Handicap system and despite a lot of questions and messages sent we received very few if any answers. The NEC decided that it was time to pull the plug and investigate getting an overhaul of the website, registration and handicap systems. A new one is expected in a short while.

Despite losing Clubs in Clare (Woodpark and Clare Road), Longford (Granard) and Dublin (CPM, Erin's Isle and Guinness) we held onto our membership and increased it slightly. We did have one new club in O'Connor's Elm Hall. We are hoping that we may have two more new clubs this year, with a new course in Arklow and one in Westport. To try and increase our Juvenile section we offered clubs an incentive, that if they reached their 2018 figure, any Juvenile registered after that would be free. Lakeside came on board with 40 new Juveniles (lets hope that they stay for 2020). As has been said by many before, we must strive to build our membership, most importantly is that when we do get new members that they are made welcome and encouraged to participate in the club activities and competitions.

On the Competition front, the entries were not great, despite a number of new ideas put in place to try and encourage more entries, we introduced a number of nett sections, (prizes in the likes of the National Matchplay, Strokeplay and Inter-County), we also changed the Mixed Foursomes Competitions to Scotch Foursomes, this worked to a certain degree and it is hoped it will improve in 2020.

Our National Championships and Competitions provided some new winners in 2019, the National Matchplay saw Mary Murray (Rocklodge) win her first, Sarah O'Neill win the Nett section and Damien Fleming win the Gents. JR Crangle won his first National Senior Strokeplay, as did Martha O'Brien in the Ladies. There were wins also for Brian O'Flynn, Derek Delaney, Bridget Shelley and Adeline Revins. In the Seniors there were wins for Patsy Farrell, John Tett, Gerry Doyle, Margaret Hogan, Frances Ryan and Margaret O'Donovan. In the under 16's we saw wins for Patrick Mitchell and Sophie Farnan and David Horan won the under 20 Strokeplay. The Gents Inter-County saw a great display from the Dublin Team to clinch the title and Tipperary won the Ladies. Kerry won the under 16 Inter-County, while in the under 16 Matchplay Glenn Towler was the victor, with Eoin O'Riordan-Looney winning the Plate. Fermoy were victors in the Inter-Club Scratch section while Riverdale won the Nett section. There was a new Challenge game in 2019 with the winners of the Intermediate and Junior Gents Provincial Inter-Counties facing off against each

other, Cork defeated Dublin in the Inters and Tipperary defeated Westmeath in the Junior.

Once again, we had large contingents heading off to play in the International Opens, in Holland, The UK and Catalonia. This year Lough Owel will host the Irish Open and we already have a large contingent going to Catalonia. Later this year the FIPPA World Cup is scheduled to take place in Chile (not confirmed and depends on certain criteria being met).

With the departure of Paul Hayes in 2019, we had to seek a replacement and his name is Shaun O'Donnell. Paul was involved in our child safety work, Strategic Plan and Governance Code compliance and some of this work had to be put on hold. However, we did have a Child Safeguarding Audit, and this was signed off by Sport Ireland (there was some minor updates and changes to be made). We must be Governance Code compliant this year and this will be a priority to get all parts into action. Shaun is learning the ropes and will be getting to grips with this work.

I would like to thank Steven Enneguess for the work he has done in securing sponsorship for Pitch and Putt Ireland, it is not an easy task.

I would like to thank Anne and Shaun for all their assistance in the Office over the year, my fellow officers for their diligence and hard work.

At this stage, I would like to thank all the people I have worked with over the past 19 years in my role as Hon. Secretary, the officers of Pitch and Putt Ireland, County Boards and the Clubs. **THANK YOU ALL FOR THE GREAT EXPERIENCE.**

Mr President, fellow NEC Officers, Paton's, Delegates and friends, it gives me great pleasure to report on the National Competitions for the 2019 season.

Championships Review

The 2019 National Championship season started as with last year, the secondary school's final held in McDonagh got us going in May, this was won by St Munchins.

The National Ladies & Gents Matchplay over the June Bank Holiday weekend was next hosted by Rocklodge. Congratulations to Damien Fleming on his victory and of course to the magnificent Mary Murray, Rocklodge. The second season of the Nett Section which was won by Sarah O'Neill from Collins. The additional section for the ladies resulted in an increase in entries which was great to see.

St Bridget's of Kildare then played host to the Ladies Strokeplay which for this year. Great plaudits must go to the St. Bridgett's club for their hosting of this championship, a fantastic course and a well-run championship. This event was won by Martha O'Brien from the Lakeside club beating Chrissy Byrne of Ryston in a thrilling 9-hole play-off. The intermediate was won by Bridgit Shelley from Lakeside and the junior by Adeline Revins from Kilbeggan.

The Gents Strokeplay was next on the calendar with Ryston club hosting. The winner of the senior was JR Crangle from Loughlinstown, and the intermediate is Brian O Flynn, Tipperary Hills and the junior by Derek Delaney from Gowran.

The last weekend of July saw a busy weekend of P&P held at the ESB club in Co. Cork, the u16 Matchplay was held in Deerpark which saw the same format as last year with groups of players ensuring all players got multiple games and a plate competition. This format continues to be popular with the juveniles as they get to play different players.

The next championship weekend saw the juveniles again come into focus with Glenville in Dublin hosting the u-16 Strokeplay, the u-20 Strokeplay and the u-16 Inter-County. The u-16 Strokeplay saw Patrick Mitchell from St Anne's come out victorious.

A new cup for the u20 championship has been kindly sponsored by the Keohane family from Cork and won by David Horan from Glenville.

The Pitch and Putt Inter-County hosted by McDonagh P&P club in Kildare was next on the calendar and I would like to congratulate them on being fantastic hosts. This continues to be a highlight of the PPUI calendar and offers a great weekend of P&P to the public. The Gents winners was Dublin and ladies by Tipperary.

This year we trialled a new event of an inter provincial between the winners of the junior and intermediate inter county, this event was held in Tullamore in November, the intermediate was won by Cork and Tipperary won the junior.

The National Scotch Foursomes was up next with Bellewstown P&P hosting.

The last National Championship of the season was the Inter-Club competition, with Lakeside hosting the final in October. A wonderful competition but another that is not very well supported despite those than do participate who speak very high of it. This is another competition that may require an adjustment to the format to ensure its continuation. I would

like to congratulate Fermoy on winning the seniors and junior event by Riverdale in the Gents competition.

I would like to take this opportunity to encourage greater participation in our National Championships. While we have seen increased numbers in a few of these championships in 2019 we are still way of the highs of a number of years ago.

Communications & Press Officer Report

Pitch & Putt Ireland Convention 22/2/20

Fellow Officers, Patrons, Delegates and Observers,

It is my great honour to present this my sixth report to you on our media activities in the past 12 months. 2019 was a year where expanding on the streaming initiatives introduced the previous year was probably our main achievement in the past year.

Streaming

After the success in Tullamore at the National Gents Matchplay Final the previous year we streamed the National Ladies Scratch Final on the new Ladies & U16 page along with the Gents Final in Rocklodge as well. I want to commend Declan Sheedy and Darren Keogh on their work on not only the Ladies Final but also the Ladies Strokeplay in St Bridgets where there was streaming during the playoffs. Mark Keohane and John Manning did a fine job again on the Gents Final with Frank Dineen providing some brief expert analysis! In Ryston at the National Gents Strokeplay connection issues hindered us particularly during the Sunday in the senior playoff. I hope we can invest in better technology and connectivity to ensure a strong signal in the future. Also I want to thank the parents/guardians of the players involved in the National U16 Matchplay Final for their written consent in allowing us to stream the Championship Final in Deerpark. There are other members of the organisation streaming at other events as well. While I welcome people trying to show others action from events I would advise people doing so to ensure that they have the permission of the organising committee of a competition because I believe such streaming should be totally at their discretion.

Facebook Pages

One hope I have for 2020 is to introduce specific pages on Facebook for Munster and Leinster events. The new Ladies & U16 page by the sub-committee of the same name has been a great success but I feel for provincial events it would be better for people in those specific provinces to be doing updates rather than by someone in another part of the country. It's not ideal for an officer to be trying to update from his or her own venue and there is nothing from another venue. Hopefully such pages will help solve that problem and the updates don't necessarily have to be done by officers themselves. Another advantage I see from having more pages is the ability to stream more, particularly at the National Matchplay.

National Matchplay Draw

The draw took place on May 12th in Rocklodge and unfortunately it did not work out in the way intended. Maybe we overstretched ourselves in what we tried to achieve but I would hope it is an experience we can learn from. One suggestion I would have is that the draw is maybe pre-recorded and witnessed by an independent observer and then played after the Q & A with John Manning in recent years that we have done as part of the draw. It can go up in full on the website at the same time. It is something I will discuss with my colleagues on the NEC prior to this year's event in Larkspur Park.

Backspin

Only two editions of the e-zine were done this year both in May and December. The first edition achieved a goal of the Ladies & U16 sub-committee to do an issue specifically related to those areas. This marked Paul Hayes' last edition prior to him leaving to take up employment with Horse Racing Ireland. I want to pay tribute to Paul again as I did at the time he left in the help and guidance he offered in putting each issue together after we re-started the project in 2016. I left the second issue go until the end of the year to give Shaun O'Donnell more time to settle into the role and we brought out a further issue prior to Christmas. I hope to discuss the project more with Shaun into 2020.

Radio/Newspapers

Our radio coverage in the main was on local stations. There are regular slots in Dublin and Kerry while our auditor Michael Sargent also spoke to John Manning each Sunday in his weekly show on East Coast FM. The more I think about this the best way maybe for our sport to grow is through local media, not just radio but local papers. From working in the industry myself I know they are very interested in taking reports of local successes in provincial and national events, something that they want to set themselves apart from the national media. The best we can hope for in terms of national coverage from what I have seen is the printing of our results and maybe a short report. The Irish Examiner and Sunday Independent do print our results consistently but it is hard to get anything solid I find without a European or even international element.

Online Media

One encouraging development recently is that we were contacted by the Federation of Irish Sport asking if we would like to be included in a database they are putting together for the sports website Pundit Arena who are working with them to give some of the smaller sporting bodies some publicity on their website. Hopefully in a World Cup year we can get something more visible for our sport. We also had a local sports reporter; Jerry Coughlan from SportsMatters visited us on the Sunday of the National Matchplay in Rocklodge and did some interviews with players and officials alike for subsequent YouTube videos. Our own YouTube channel has 93 subscribers at present, we used it for Inter-County videos this year but it is something I would like to use more if we can as well as our other social media in Twitter and Instagram.

Other

The redesign of our website offers the opportunity as well to develop some new features. Hopefully we can make it a viable and active source of information and content for our members to draw from. Photos are always something we can't have enough of and I would certainly welcome any volunteers for same, not just of presentations but action shots as well.

I want to start concluding my report by thanking a few people as well as offering others some well wishes. Firstly to Vincent Allen, I wish him a happy retirement from writing his weekly Echo column in Cork. Vincent and Phil have been a great source of encouragement to me since I took on this role back in 2014. Also I want to thank John Manning for all his assistance, especially since September when I took up new employment in my working life. I also want to wish Michael well in stepping down for the position of Honorary Secretary; we will still be working with Michael of course in his role of Office Administrator.

Thanks to all those who helped me out in smaller ways, whether it was with photos, videoing or writing. As the slogan of a supermarket says 'every little helps'.

I shall be committing to the position for one further year and I intend to assess whether I can continue more long-term in the role afterwards as I will see if I can juggle it with my new employment over the course of a full year.

Thanks to my NEC colleagues, both collectively and individually for their assistance this year as well as Anne in the office.
